CONFIRMATION CONCERNING HEALTH PROTECTION IN THE WORKPLACE (Covid-19)

Version 08 dated 07 February 2022, subject to change due to official order at any time.

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Gender note: For ease of reading, male pronouns are used in all Covid-19 documents. The female form is of course always included.

Pursuant to Article 6 of the Labour Code (ArG; SR 822.11), the employer undertakes to avoid any impairment to the health of its employees. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, it has also ensured that the requirements imposed by the Federal Council, the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH) and the individual cantons can be observed and implemented during work.

Employees are also obliged to comply with the requirements concerning health protection. By signing this document you confirm the following points:

Health protection requirements

- If you are sick, stay at home! Applies to cough, sore throat, shortness of breath with or without fever, chills, or muscle aches. The employee is not allowed to be present at the shooting location with the aforementioned symptoms. A negative PCR test may allow participation after thorough examination and after explicit permission by the Set Officer. The employer may require a medical certificate.
- Keep your distance! The distance between two persons must be at least 1.5 metres. This applies to all film locations, side rooms, break and rest rooms. If this is not possible, the contact time must be as short as possible and suitable protective measures (mask, disinfection, gloves) must be implemented.
- No shaking hands, no welcome/goodbye kisses, no hugs.
- Wash your hands thoroughly and regularly with soap and water. This is especially important before arrival at the workplace, before and after breaks and before and after meetings/filming.
- Use disinfectants, masks and gloves regularly.
- Disinfect work tools before/after each use.
- Wherever possible, work tools should not be shared.
- Do not leave newspapers/magazines in the common areas.
- No sharing of objects such as mobile phones, glasses, etc.
- Cough and sneeze into a handkerchief or the crook of your arm.

According to Covid 19 Regulation 2 Annex 6 (as of 26.3.2021), persons at particular risk are defined as:

Elderly people *(The risk of a severe course of disease with the new coronavirus increases with age. From the age of 50, the hospitalisation rate also increases. Pre-existing conditions also increase the risk.)*

Pregnant women

Adults with the following pre-existing conditions

- High blood pressure
- Cardiovascular diseases
- Diabetes
- Chronic lung and respiratory diseases
- Cancer
- Diseases and therapies that weaken the immune system
- Obesity grade II (BMI \geq 35 kg/m²)
- Liver cirrhosis
- Chronic kidney disease
- Trisomy 21

I am not aware of having had any contact with persons suffering from coronavirus during the last 14 days. As far as I know, no one in my direct personal or professional environment has contracted coronavirus in the last 14 days.

WHAT TO DO IF COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OCCUR

Covid-19 symptoms

Currently known Covid-19 symptoms are

- Acute respiratory disease (e.g. cough (usually dry), sore throat, shortness of breath, chest pain)
- Fever without other cause
- Sudden loss of the sense of smell and/or taste
- Acute confusion or unexplained deterioration in the general condition of older people (65+).

The following symptoms are additionally possible

- Headache
- General weakness
- Malaise
- Muscle aches
- Runny nose
- Gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, abdominal pain)
- Skin rashes

In case of uncertainty, the coronavirus check of the FOPH must be carried out in any case!

If the employee is already on set, the following procedure applies:

1. Isolate

- Cease contact with all crew members immediately
- Do not enter neuralgic points on the set
- Disinfect hands
- Have temperature taken twice at 15-minute intervals, leave the set immediately if symptoms are detected
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2. Report

Contact production manager, producer, possibly Covid-19 officer by phone and report suspicion.

3. Seek medical advice

- GP, medical officers, medical hotline or FOPH Infoline Coronavirus: +41 58 463 00 00
- Do not visit a doctor unannounced
- Visit hospital emergency department only in case of severe symptoms

4. Diagnosis

If there is reasonable suspicion, the doctor and/or production management can order a coronavirus test.

5. Domestic quarantine

- Stay at home (no walks, shopping etc.)
- Do not come to work
- Seek / request help for purchases and errands

6. Report contact person

In accordance with the instructions of the health department, the production management reports the case to the health department and follows its instructions.

7. Monitor state of health

- Check symptoms regularly
- If symptoms persist, follow medical advice
